DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

Coaches, poolside assistants and Committee Members have the responsibility and authority to deal with minor disciplinary problems.

Minor problems will be dealt with as follows:

1. A quiet word privately with the individual pointing out the problem and why it is unacceptable.
2. Session leader may ask individuals to take time out on poolside.
3. If this has little or no effect, the person dealing with the problem in the first instance and the session leader may decide to inform a parent to seek their support.
4. Further incidents are likely to lead to the offender being asked to leave the pool. The parents will be informed as to why the action has been taken by the club official who initiated it, whilst keeping the session leader fully informed of developments.
5. Swimmer/parent can at any time lodge an appeal in writing to the club welfare officer/chairperson.

Members of the Committee should be informed at stage three or four in order to support the club official.

Any more serious matter will be dealt with by the Committee under the ASA judicial laws and may result in the offender being suspended or excluded from the Club. An exclusion from the Club should be ratified by the Committee.

At any time those involved are free to state their point of view.

The above applies to any person on poolside during club sessions.
